

NOTICE TO MARINERS Nº 6 - 2009

Mooring / Berthing of vessels at Newhaven

For the safety of all vessels and all persons within Newhaven Harbour limits, Commercial, Fishing and Leisure craft each have their designated and authorised berthing / mooring sites which they must strictly adhere to.

Under no circumstances will vessels berth/moor, or use the facilities of, anywhere else in the Harbour Limits without express permission from the Port Authority.

Vessels will at all times obey any directions given to them by Newhaven Port Authority.

Mooring anywhere else in the Harbour, or using any other facilities without permission, could endanger lives, be a hazard to navigation, disrupt the efficient operation of the Port, and be illegal.

Failure to comply with the above will result in vessels being seized and owners / skippers / masters being prosecuted.
