

## **LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS N° 17 – 2026**

## Removal of RoRo2 Pontoon and associated navigation lights

Mariners are advised that the RoRo2 pontoon is planned to be removed from Newhaven Port during the next suitable weather window. In preparation for the removal the Navigation lights and traffic signal light on the RoRo2 pontoon have been extinguished.

The Signal lights will be re-established in the vicinity when possible.

Once RoRo2 has been removed, the remaining pilot boat pontoon will be set back from the navigable channel and will no longer present the same requirement for navigation lights. On this basis, it is proposed that the navigation lights are removed as part of the RoRo2 removal works.

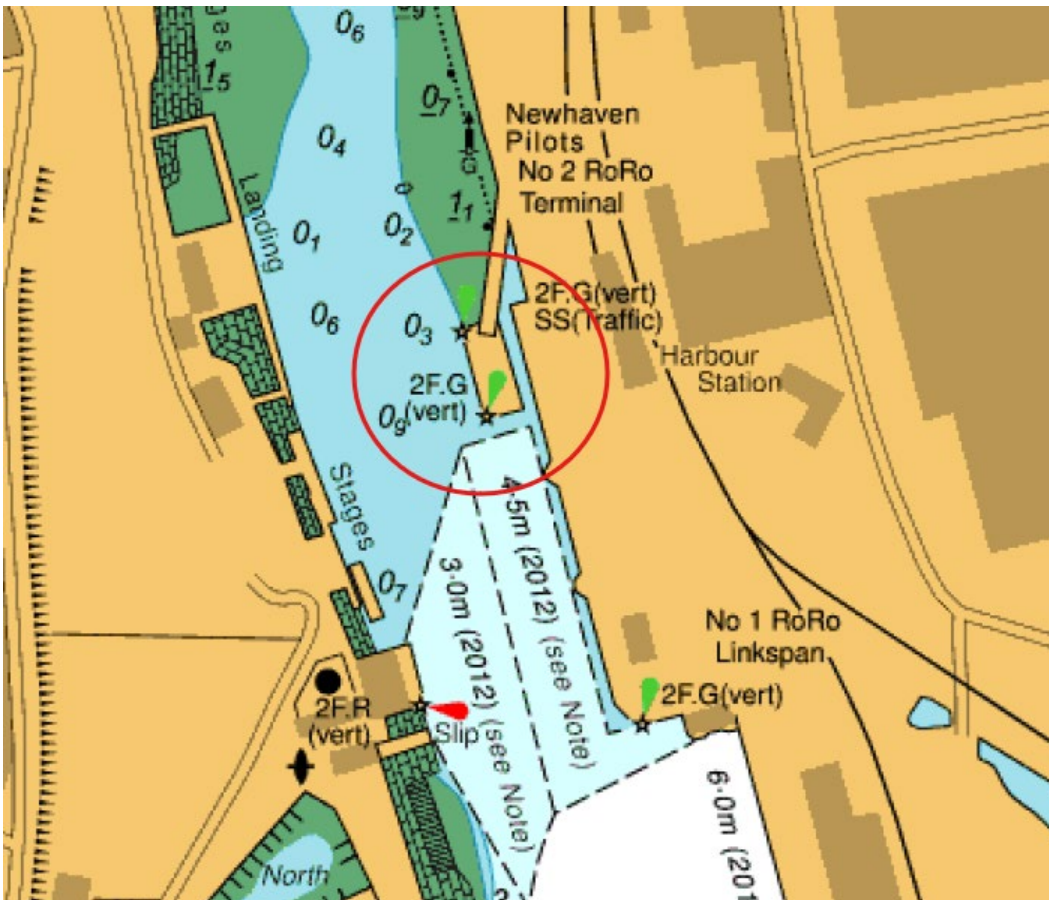


Figure 1 - Chartlet showing position of RoRo2 and associated lights
